## **SBMSA Football Mission Statement**

**“To provide an opportunity for our neighborhood youth to participate in a sports environment that allows for their growth and development in a safe, fair, positive and competitive league, with emphasis on the importance of building character, sportsmanship, and team unity in order to obtain the goals of champions.”**

## History of the Sports Association

In the spring of 1960 a few local fathers from the Spring Branch area started a baseball league composed of six baseball teams of 11 and 12 year old boys. The purpose was to start a program not affiliated with any national organization in order to not have to conform to national rules. The group wanted from the beginning to be able to tailor the program and modify the rules to meet the needs of the youngsters in Spring Branch. In May 1961 the organization filed for their charter with the State of Texas, thus beginning the Spring Branch-Memorial Sports Association. A board of directors was elected with S.L. Hidemann as the first president, A.W. Zajcek vice president, C.E. Frost secretary and Foster Moore treasurer. Other directors were J.C. Trotter, Bill Poarch, Pete Phillips, Bill Manning, John Holloway and Irvin Andrews. Holloway is still the ex officio member of the present Board of Directors.

In 1963 the Girls' Softball program was inaugurated and Mrs. Gladys Chaney was the first commissioner of the girls' program. In 1964 other younger age groups were added to the boys' baseball program. At that time within the youngest age group there was a group that preferred to play tee ball and a group that wished to play regular baseball. Since there were no national rules to conform to, the Association was able to provide for both.

In 1965 the Sports Association had enough participants to divide into two levels of play designated as American and National Leagues. The purpose of this was to group boys according to ability and give more of them an opportunity to compete at their own level. At this time the program had grown to 200 teams necessitating the programs to be divided into five different geographical areas. Playing fields were located on private property donated by Pacific Valve, Capital Steel and Wyatt Industries, with a fourth complex added at Swipe Industries in 1968 until moving to SBISD property in the late 1960's.

After experimenting with different size fields and rule variations in the baseball program a group of 11 and 12 year old boys demonstrated a game under our rules at the Boys' Baseball Division World Series held in Kingsville in 1967. As a result of this, the rules including 70 foot base paths, a 48 foot pitching distance and allowable lead-offs and steals were adopted by this national organization in 1968 for all their leagues. This organization, now changed to PONY (Protect Our Nation's Youth), also uses the Sports Association's principle of changing the sizes of the playing fields in both baseball and softball to adjust to the physical potential and limitations of participants, leaving the rules of the game alone as much as possible. The Sports Association baseball program has five different sizes of playing field and pitching distances, each changing every two years with the growth of the players.

Beginning in 1968, the Sports Association acquired Pony and Colt franchises (ages 13-16) to begin the Senior Baseball program. Also inherited were the existing lighted Pony Field at Spring Branch High School and an agreement with the school district to use existing high school fields. Since that time the Association has lighted in order the high school fields at Westchester High, Spring Woods High, Memorial High, and finally both Stratford and Northbrook High School fields in 1975.

In 1969 two Junior Baseball lighted fields were constructed at Spring Forest Junior High followed in 1972 by fields at Memorial Junior High, Spring Woods Junior High and Spring Branch Elementary (softball). In 1973 the Landrum Junior High complex was built (since deactivated), a second complex added at Memorial Junior High and a single field added at Spring Forest Junior High. These new game facilities built on school sites were for replacement of fields lost from private property as well as to accommodate the rapid growth of the entire program. Two additional softball fields were built at Spring Branch Elementary in 1975 with the

fifth added in 1976 to complete new lighted field construction insofar as Sports Association programs are concerned. During this same time period the Association also used four city park fields for the baseball, softball, and football programs. The Association has also erected about thirty practice backstops on school property. A current count of Sports Association facilities reveals 21 lighted fields and 8 daylight fields, used for baseball and softball in the spring and summer and for football, Boys' Soccer and Girls' Soccer in the fall.

In 1965 the football program was added as a fall sport. In the early days boys played for their respective schools. Freshman was 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade, JV was 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> and Varsity was for those boys that did not make the JV weight. In 1969 there was no "ball carrier" weight limit and the upper weight limit was 85#. Compare that with today's weight limits for 6<sup>th</sup> graders which are 110 pounds to carry the ball and 185 pounds as the upper limit. Each elementary school in the district had an 'A' and a 'B' team for each age group and, for some schools, a second 'B' team was required. In 1972 there were 109 teams playing tackle football in SBMSA.

The championship games were played at Tully stadium. All players were tasked with selling tickets to these games and proceeds were used to fund college scholarships that were awarded to SBISD athletes. The championships were called the Scholarship Bowl. The boys from each age group that sold the most tickets were awarded a new football for their efforts.

As the area matured, demographics changed and the number of school-aged children decreased, participation steadily dropped off. In 1989 a flag football division was started which doubled its numbers the following year. In 1995 tackle football had four freshman teams, 8 JV teams and 6 Varsity teams. The following year football went to a draft as a means of ensuring that each team had a better chance to compete. In 2001 football moved the Varsity program to full-sized fields and spent monies to improve the fields at Spring Woods and Memorial middle schools where Varsity games are played on the weekends only. The football program also improved and irrigated the practice fields at other SBISD middle schools.

The flag program, the draft, and the rejuvenation of our neighborhoods have led to a steady increase in football participants. In 2005 there were 30 flag teams, 12 Freshman, 18 JV, and 12 Varsity – 72 teams and over 1,200 kids participating in SBMSA football.

In 1977 a soccer program was added to the Association. This program was very popular and it has grown rapidly.

In the fall of 1990 a basketball program was added using the school district gymnasiums for playing facilities. Thirty-eight boys' teams competed this first year with a girls' program added the next year.

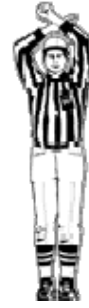

(Folded arms.)



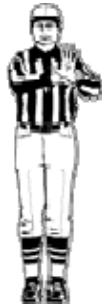
**False start, illegal formation, or kickoff or safety kick out of bounds**  
(Forearms rotated over and over in front of body.)



**Illegal motion at snap**  
(Horizontal arc with one hand.)

(Grasping one wrist, the fist clenched, in front of chest.)



**Illegal use of hands, arms, or body**  
(Grasping one wrist, the hand open and facing forward, in front of chest.)



**Penalty refused, incomplete pass, play over, or missed field goal or extra point**  
(Hands shifted in horizontal plane.)



**Pass juggled in-bounds and caught out of bounds**  
(Hands up and down in front of chest (following incomplete pass signal).)



**Illegal forward pass**  
(One hand waved behind back followed by loss of down signal.)



**Loss of down**  
(Both hands held behind head.)



**Intentional grounding of pass**  
(Parallel arms waved in a diagonal plane across body. Followed by loss of down signal.)



**Interference with forward pass or fair catch**  
(Hands open and extended forward from shoulders with hands vertical.)



**Invalid fair-catch signal**  
(One hand waved above head.)



**Ineligible receiver or ineligible member of kicking team down-field**  
(Right hand touching top of cap.)



**Illegal contact**  
(One open hand extended forward.)



**Interlocking interference, pushing, or helping runner**  
(Pushing movement of hands to front with arms downward.)

**Touching a forward pass or scrimmage kick**  
(Diagonal motion of one hand across another.)



**Illegal cut**  
(Hand striking front of thigh.)



**Illegal crackback**  
(Strike of an open right hand against the right mid-thigh preceded by personal foul signal.)



**Player disqualified**  
(Ejection signal.)



**Tripping**  
(Repeated action of right foot in back of left heel.)



**Uncatchable forward pass**  
(Palm of right hand held parallel to ground above head and moved back and forth.)



**Twelve men in offensive huddle or too many men on the field**  
(Both hands on top of head.)



**Face mask**  
(Grasping face mask with one hand.)



**Illegal shift**  
(Horizontal arcs with two hands.)



**Reset play clock - 25 seconds**  
(Pump one arm vertically.)



**Reset play clock - 40 seconds**  
(Pump two arms vertically.)



**Roughing the Kicker**  
(One wrist striking the other above head followed by swinging leg)



**Roughing the Passer**  
(One wrist striking the other above head followed by raised arm swinging forward)



**Major Face Mask**  
(One wrist striking the other above head followed by grasping face mask)



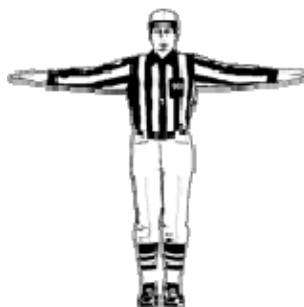
**Illegal block below the waist**  
(One hand striking front of thigh preceded by personal-foul signal.)



**Chop block**  
(Both hands striking side of thighs preceded by personal-foul signal.)



**Clipping**  
(One hand striking back of calf preceded by personal-foul signal.)

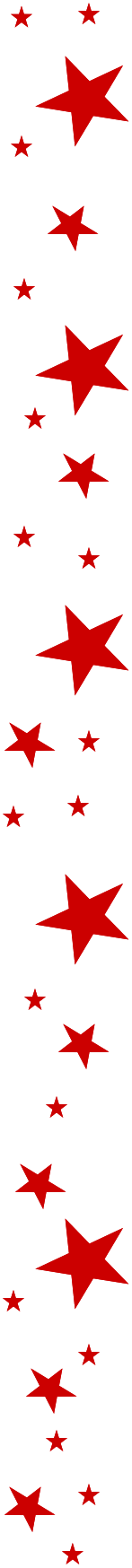
