Playing Time:

- All players must play a minimum of two (2) quarters. A player who comes in or out as a mid-quarter (injury) substitution shall be deemed to have played one-half of the quarter.

Substitutions:

- Substitutions will be at the end of each quarter, (unless an injury occurs).

Build-Out Line:

- When the goalkeeper has the ball, and for all goal kicks, the attacking team must retreat behind the build-out line. The goalkeeper or goal kick taker may play or distribute the ball at his own risk before the attackers have reached the build-out line.
- Goalkeepers may not punt or drop-kick the ball; they may roll it, throw it or play it with the foot while it is rolling on the ground or at rest.
- Once the goalkeeper or the goal kick taker plays the ball, the attacking team may not cross the build-out line until (i) the ball is touched by a second member of the team playing the ball, (ii) the goalkeeper dribbles the ball outside the penalty area or (iii) the ball crosses the build-out line.

Free Kicks (There are NO PENALTY KICKS):

- Defenders must stand back six (6) yards on free kicks, and corner kicks. For direct kicks awarded to attacking team in the penalty area, the ball is moved back to the nearest point on the edge of the penalty area.

Other Rules and Regulations:

- Parents and spectators on opposite side of field to players and coaches.
- No coach, parent or spectator behind the goal lines.
- All players must wear shin guards. No jewelry, watches, rings, or anything that could cause harm to any player. No aluminum cleats. Casts subject to referee approval.
- Minimum # of players to start is four (4). Maximum of six (6) players on field at any time.
- Forfeit for failure to take field ten (10) minutes after scheduled start.
- Kick-off each quarter. Alternate kick-offs by teams each quarter. Reverse sides at half. Goals **cannot** be scored directly from kick-offs. A goal can be scored on goal kicks and corner kicks.
- Goal kicks should be taken within 2-3 yards of the goal line anywhere across width of the goal area.
- Throw-ins as per FIFA, with re-takes permitted to allow referee to teach proper throw-in technique
- The goalkeeper shall be considered to have possession of the ball at any time the ball is motionless and being touched by any part of the goalkeeper's hand, trapped, or held.
- No offside penalty.
- No sliding tackles.
- Playoffs Only: In a shoot-out situation, all players are eligible to be selected as a penalty taker.
- All other rules as per FIFA.
