SBMSA RULES—SENIORS

- Home/visitor team on same side of field, on either half of midfield.
- ALL parents/spectators on the opposite side of the field from players/coaches.
- No person is allowed behind the goal lines or beyond the penalty areas at sidelines.
- Casts (with or without modification) and any form of jewelry or accessory permitted only with approval of the game official.
- All players must wear shin guards. Shin guards are to be worn underneath the socks.
- Minimum number of players to begin play is 9 per team. Maximum number of players on field is 11 per team.
- Failure to take the field within 10 minutes of the game start time results in a forfeit, unless approved by the league commissioner.
- Kickoff each quarter. Alternate kickoffs by team each quarter. Reverse sides of field at half. Goals may be scored on kickoffs and goal kicks.
- Mid-quarter hydration breaks may be approved by game official on days with dangerous heat and/or in accordance with the SBMSA Heat Policy.
- Open substitutions allowed at stoppage of play and with official approval. Players leaving for injury may return to play. Blood rule and concussion rule to apply.
- All players must play a minimum of 34 minutes (1/2 of regulation time).
- Offsides enforced per FIFA rules. Throw-ins per FIFA rules. No retakes on throw-ins.
- Goalkeeper is considered to have possession of the ball if the ball is motionless AND being held, trapped, or touched by any part of the goalkeeper's body.
- Headers are allowed. Slide tackles are legal as long as they are not deemed a dangerous play in the judgement of the referee.
- All other rules as per FIFA.
